I. Requirements

- A. Shots
 - 1. Kennel Cough (Bordatella)
 - 2. Rabies
 - 3. Distemper Parvo DHPP
- B. Spayed or Neutered
 - 1. Males by one year or earlier if mounting or marking becomes a problem
 - 2. Females by eight months
- C. Other Medical
 - 1. Flea and Tick treatment required all year round
 - 2. Dogs must be in good overall health to attend: includes coat, ears, eyes, mouth
 - 3. Newly rescued/adopted dogs and puppies need to provide clean fecal test from their vet/shelter
- D. Health
- 1. If your dog is showing symptoms of abnormal **coughing**, please keep them home and contact your veterinarian for a proper diagnosis
- 2. If your dog has a noticeable change in their **stool**, please keep your dog home and contact your veterinarian for a proper diagnosis
- II. Hours of Operation
 - A. Weekdays 6:30am-6:30pm
 - 1. No drop-offs on Friday after 11am except for boarding
 - B. Saturday 8am-4pm: East Syracuse Daycare ONLY
 - C. Closed major holidays; check board in lobby or Facebook for other closings
- D. Sometimes will close during winter when there is an emergency travel advisory. Call daycare on storm days
 - III. Attendance
 - A. Starting
 - 1. Shot records and Pet Profile must be turned in by or on first day
 - 2. First day dogs should be at daycare by 7am on weekdays and 8am on
- Saturdays.
- 3. Should continue to arrive early till dog is comfortable coming in on its
- own.
- B. Frequency
 - 1. K-9 Kamp recommends coming at least 1 day a week
 - 2. K-9 Kamp requires 1 day every other week to stay eligible for boarding
- 3. K-9 Kamp recommends being consistent with your dogs schedule for daycare. If changing days we recommend coming early by 7am that day
